Vote Counting Resumes in 2012

Los Angeles, California -Vote counting for the June 8 primary election has finally ended. Moreno picked up 15,000 more votes and ended with 97,000 votes. She was 1% short of the total votes of making it to the November runoff. Moreno spent only 20 cents per vote. Her opponents who are facing a runoff in November have spent in excess of \$2.00 per vote. Unfortunately, this election will be about who spent the most money rather than qualifications.
